What we examine

Pillar	Sample focus questions
Leadership	Do leaders model high reliability mindsets? Is decision latency adding risk?
Culture	How freely does bad news travel? Are near misses investigated or ignored?
Management System	Are procedures, MOC, and work controls aligned and followed?
Operational Feedback	Are KPIs and learning loops calibrated to reality or wishful thinking?

Three Phase Approach

- Pre assessment alignment (virtual, 1 week out): clarify scope and success criteria; collect key documents and performance data.
- **72 hour immersion** (on-site): direct observation, structured leadership interviews, rapid system reviews, and real time sense making huddles.
- **Executive read out & roadmap** (day 4): heat map of strengths, gaps, and quick wins; risk ranked action plan with owners and timelines.
